Put your honey where your mouth is!

The cost of living crisis is greating the strain on young carers. To continue to support these children through the crisis, we are continuing to evaluate our services and introduce any help we can to the many disadvantaged children affected. We have increased our online presence, are extending our reach, with a new house opening in Scotland later this year and developing a food service to help those missing out on free school meals in the holidays. We recieve no government support and rely entirely on generous people like you to reach as many young carers as possible. Here are some ideas to get you started. Thank you so much for your support!

Getting started

The easiest way to collect donations is to set up a free Honey Pot Enthuse page. All you need to do is find the Enthuse website on Google, click 'for supporters' and follow the set-up guide. Once you created your own fundraising page on Enthuse (it takes less than 5 minutes), share the link with any colleagues, friends or family who participate in your events and/or are happy to donate.

Team/group challenge

- Agree on a challenge e.g. everyone bake a cake, sing or perform a dance
- Once the challenge has been completed, ask your team to share photos or videos with you, and remember to donate
- Finally collate all the photos and videos and share them with your team

Share a recipe

- Ask colleagues to share their favourite recipes
- Compile them into a PDF document
- Ask colleagues for a donation to receive the recipe pack



Donate your daily coffee

- If you're working from home, why not save the money you spend on commuting, coffee or lunch
- Consider donating some of these savings. This can be done individually or as a team

Physical activities



- Set a virtual team or individual, physical challenge. From a steps challenge to squats, or a kind deed a day, the opportunities are endless.
- Ask participants to pay a donation to enter
- Encourage participants to share photos to motivate everyone.



Guess the baby photo

- Ask your colleagues to send you some baby photos of themselves
- Email your work team the baby photo collage and ask for a donation to take part in guessing who is who.



Guess the number of sweets

- Fill a jar with sweets - make sure you count them!
- Take a photo and send it around to your team
- Ask for a donation to guess how many sweets are in the jar
- The closest to the right number wins



Wine tasting

- Is someone in your team a wine connoisseur?
- Ask them to choose a selection of wines and share the list with colleagues
- Set up a virtual wine tasting evening
- Ask your team to donate to take part



Knowledge sharing



- Teach a language, cookery or skill virtually
- Host a virtual lesson
- Put it in people's calendars and ask attendees to donate



Arts and crafts



- Is there someone in your team that could lead an arts and crafts challenge like a painting or an origami competition?
- Ask colleagues for a donation to take part

Come dine with Honeypot

- Invite your friends, colleagues or family round for a meal.
- Ask them to make a donation to Honeypot
- Take a photo and send it to your team to encourage them to do the same
